St Leonards National Junior Golf Championships 2017/18

Competition Information

- Competitors wishing to play a practice round should contact The Links on 01334 466666 to book a tee time 2 weeks in advance, otherwise you may only book the day before you wish to play.
- The Director of Golf must receive the completed **Entry Form** and **Entry Fee** by **12 noon** on the **28th February 2018**.
Late entries will not be accepted unless there are available tee times.
- Trolleys will be available free of charge on the day of the competition.
- On the day of the competition all competitors must register at the Pilmour Cottage at least 30 minutes before their tee time, at which time any handicap adjustments should be notified.
- There will be a Longest Drive competition using Trackman and also a 9-Hole Putting Competition. These will run between 11.00am and 3.00pm for those who wish to participate.

Competition Rules

- No trolley pullers or caddies are allowed. If, during the Championship, a player is injured, the committee may, in exceptional circumstances appoint a trolley puller.
- Parents/Guardians/Relatives may not walk on the fairways or speak to the competitors during play.
- On the Strathtyrum one round of stroke play will be played with prizes awarded for the lowest net and scratch scores in each age group. In the event of a tie, the positions will be determined by back nine score, last six then last 3 score.
- The maximum handicap for girls will be 36 and for boys 28.
- Strathtyrum Course – Yellow Tees for Boys and Red Tees for Girls.
- No Preferred Lies.
- On the Balgove competitors will be allocated a set number of shots depending on their age group and they will try to play as many holes as possible with their stroke allocation. Prizes will be awarded in each age group. St Leonards pupils will accompany each group to help with scoring etc.
- The committee reserves the right to make any changes to starting times or the method of play which may become necessary in order to overcome difficulties arising during the Championships and to ensure as equitable a result as possible.
- The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules as laid down by the committee.
Any disputes will be settled by the committee, whose decision will be final.

The U15 and Over 15 Championships will be held on Wednesday 26th September 2018
