General Information

- The Championship will take place on The Eden, Strathtyrum and Balgove golf courses.
- Competitors wishing to play a practice round should contact The Links on 01334 466666 to book a tee time two weeks in advance. Otherwise, you may only book the day before you wish to play. Green fees will apply and are not included.
- **Entry forms must be received by midnight on Sunday, 17th March 2019.**

- Late entries will only be accepted if there are available tee times. They will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.
- Trolleys will be available free of charge on the day of competition.
- On the day of the competition all competitors must register at least 30 minutes before their tee time.
- There will be a separate registration area for each golf course (Eden, Strathtyrum and Balgove) Please follow signage for these. The registration areas will be located in, or very close to, the Eden Clubhouse.
- There will be Longest Drive, Longest Putt and Nearest the Pin competitions using Trackman. These will run between from 11.00am and 3.00pm for those who wish to participate. They will be located at The Golf Academy.
- Lunch will be included in the entry fee.
- Cancellation of entry must be communicated to the Championship Department a minimum of 48 hours before play. A full refund of the entrance fee will be allowed. There will be no refund if cancelled within 48 hours of play, unless in exceptional circumstances.

Competition Rules

- **Age-** Competitors must be aged **under 14 years old** on the day of competition (26th April 2019)
- No trolley pullers or caddies are allowed. If, during the Championship, a player is injured, the committee may, in exceptional circumstances appoint a trolley puller.
- Parents/Guardians/Relatives are not permitted on the course, at any stage. Failure to comply **WILL** result in disqualification. Ropes on the Balgove course will indicate the point that only competitors may cross. Committee decision on this is final.
- There will be several competition categories running on the day, organised by course:

Balgove

Flag Competition: Each player is awarded a set number of shots, and the challenge is to get as far round the course as possible in the shots you are given. The golfer who gets furthest round the course, will be the winner. A senior pupil from the St Leonards Golf Programme will accompany each group to help with scoring.

- Under 9 boys and girl's winner (45 shots)
- Under 11 boys and girl's winner (40 shots)

Strathtyrum

- Under 14 best 9-hole score boys and girls (anybody **without** a handicap, aged 11-13)
- Under 14 best nett score boys and girls, 18 holes (handicap 25-36)
- Under 14 best scratch score boys and girls (handicap 25-36)

Eden

- Under 14 best nett score boys and girls, 18 holes (handicap must be 24 or below)
- Under 14 best scratch score boys and girls (handicap must be 24 or lower)

Please Note:

- The maximum handicap for either 18-hole event is 36.
- Balgove Course – all competitors will play from same tees.
- Strathtyrum/Eden Courses – boys play from yellow tees, and girls play from red tees.
- No Preferred Lies.
- The committee reserves the right to make any changes to starting times or the method of play which may become necessary in order to overcome difficulties arising during the Championship, and to ensure as equitable a result as possible.
- The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules as laid down by the committee.
- Any disputes will be settled by the committee whose decision will be final.
