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## GIRFEC: Getting It Right For Every Child The Well-being Indicators

<b>Safe</b>	Protected from abuse, neglect or harm at home, at school and in the community.
<b>Healthy</b>	Having the highest attainable standards of physical and mental health, access to suitable healthcare and support in learning to make healthy and safe choices.
<b>Achieving</b>	Being supported and guided in their learning and in the development of their skills, confidence and self-esteem at home, at school and in the community.
<b>Nurtured</b>	Having a nurturing place to live, in a family setting with additional help of needed or, where this is not possible, in a suitable care setting.
<b>Active</b>	Having opportunities to take part in activities such as play, recreation and sport which contribute to healthy growth and development, both at home and in the community.
<b>Respected</b>	Having the opportunity, along with carers, to be heard and involved in decisions which affect them.
<b>Responsible</b>	Having opportunities and encouragement to play active and responsible roles in their schools and communities and, where necessary, having appropriate guidance and supervision and being involved in decisions that affect them.

1. What is getting in the way of this young person's wellbeing?
2. Do I have all the information I need to help this young person?
3. What can I do now to help this young person?
4. What can the school do to help this young person?
5. What additional help, if any, may be needed from others?
